## **TKI** **open 22\_liegen resting**

What is there to be gained when we lose the ground from under our feet? During the COVID-19 pandemic everything that we took for granted has collapsed. Let's leave it like that! When you lie down, you surrender, you shift your horizon, bring hierarchy down to its knees, allow yourself to be exhausted, embrace slowness. TKI open 22 supports the collapse, the pause, reflection, laziness, rest and giving things up. Who does fatigue link us with? What does postponement promise? What can we let go to open up for new forms of community?

TKI open 22 invites artists and creative people to take time. Time for open-ended research, for searching for alternatives in life to the paradigm of non-stop activity. Time to show solidarity, to acknowledge and share privileges, to distinguish the essential from the insignificant, to approach joyful utopias, to trust in the hiatus. Time for fundamental questions: Do we want to carry on as before? How else could the arts and cultural production look? Which self-images do we base our work on? What are we longing for? Who or what is lacking? What should we demand?

Let us all rest, lay down the world and work. What do you want to do when, suddenly, there is nothing more you have to do?

### **Criteria**

- Explicit engagement with the theme of the call
- Originality and quality of the realisation
- Reference to Tyrol
- Realisation of the project within the year 2022
- Sensitive handling of gender issues and societal mechanisms of exclusion, in the wording of the project, its concept and its realisation

### **Funding**

TKI open 22 has a total of 100.000 euros of funding available from the federal administration of Tyrol. The selected projects may be fully funded by TKI open.

## Online submission

Please email your project proposal in German in pdf format to [office@tki.at](mailto:office@tki.at).

The proposal must include:

- Completed form with the basic details (download from [www.tki.at](http://www.tki.at))
- Detailed description of the project (5 pages max.)
- Calculation of the costs, plus funding plan
- Schedule for the realisation of the project
- Details on the proposers

## Who can enter?

Charitable cultural initiatives and collectives as well as individuals

## Who cannot enter?

- Public bodies, party-political or religious organisations or commercial cultural event organisers and businesses
- Ongoing or completed projects or projects already funded by TKI open (repeat projects)
- Projects that already receive support from the cultural department of the federal administration of Tyrol

## Jury

A jury of experts from the region and beyond will select the most convincing projects in a public jury meeting and will recommend these for funding to the federal administration of Tyrol. Only one project per entrant can be selected.

## Dates

- Submission of proposals closes at midnight on Sunday 10.10.2021
- Public jury meeting: Saturday 13.11.2021
