## TKI open 24\_putting out feelers

Throw each other rope ladders, put out feelers – underneath imagined boundaries and across them – plough unknown terrain!

TKI open 24 invites cultural initiatives, artists, and culturally active people to reach out, team up, nudge each other, graze on new pastures, rework their own soil and to ask: What can grow on the excavated material?

We are looking for projects that reflect cultural togetherness and that negotiate the societal role of art and cultural activity as well as their current forms.

TKI open 24 wants to know: Are we still asking the right questions in art and in cultural initiatives? And are these still relevant beyond our own box? Whom do they affect and how? What is happening in other areas of society, for instance in civil society, politics, science? What is their potential for cultural activity? What possibly new and unusual alliances does it take for mutually supportive togetherness and to face current challenges?

So, meet up in all your diversity, collaborate, make conflicts visible and negotiable, scan the field beyond your (culture) bubble and negotiate future cultural interactions.

### Funding

TKI open 24 has a total of 100.000 euros of funding available from the federal administration of Tyrol. The selected projects may be fully funded by TKI open.

### Who can enter?

Charitable cultural initiatives and collectives as well as individuals

### Who cannot enter?

- Public bodies, party-political or religious organisations or commercial cultural event organisers and businesses
- Ongoing or completed projects or projects already funded by TKI open (repeat projects)
- Projects that already receive support from the cultural department of the federal administration of Tyrol

## Criteria

- Explicit engagement with the theme of the call
- Originality and quality of the realisation
- Reference to Tyrol
- Realisation of the project within the year 2024
- Sensitive handling of gender issues and societal mechanisms of exclusion, in the wording of the project, its concept and its realisation

Required documents:

- Detailed description of the project (5 pages max.)
- Calculation of the costs, plus funding plan
- Schedule
- Details on the proposers

## Jury

A transregional expert jury will select the most convincing projects in an online jury meeting and submit them to the Tyrolean administration for funding. The meeting is being recorded and made available to interested parties soon after. Only one project per entrant can be selected.
