### Who can enter?

charitable cultural initiatives and collectives as well as individuals

## Who cannot enter?

- public bodies, party-political or religious organisations or commercial cultural event organisers and businesses
- ongoing or completed projects or projects already funded by TKI open (repeat projects)
- projects that already receive support from the cultural department of the federal administration of Tyrol

### Criteria

$\longrightarrow$	explicit engagement with the theme of the call
$\longrightarrow$	originality and quality of the realisation
$\longrightarrow$	reference to Tyrol
$\longrightarrow$	realisation of the project within the year 2026
$\longrightarrow$	sensitive handling of gender issues and societal mechanisms of exclusion, in the
	wording of the project, its concept and its realisation

Required documents:

$\longrightarrow$	detailed description of the project (5 pages max.)
$\longrightarrow$	calculation of the costs, plus funding plan
$\longrightarrow$	schedule
$\longrightarrow$	details on the proposers
